**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 939 provides that the Homemade Food Freedom Act (HFFA) shall not prohibit the sale of homemade food for home consumption from a retail space located at the ranch, farm, or home where the food is produced, requires that retailers selling homemade food under the provisions of the HFFA must inform informed end consumers and display signature indicating that the homemade food has not been inspected. The proposal exempts farms selling ungraded milk and eggs produced from their own livestock from certain provisions of the law and requires ungraded milk or milk products to follow certain requirements to be sold at a farmers market or sold by third-party vendors.

A fiscal impact is pending.
