8 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to children; providing that certain
10 determination be made in certain circumstance;
11 directing the Department of Human Services to
12 document certain information; providing that further
13 investigation shall not occur if findings are
14 unsubstantiated; providing for codification; and
15 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 410.2 of Title 10, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. For noncompliance with the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities
22 Licensing Act or the rules of the Department of Human Services to
23 receive a serious designation, a determination shall be made that
24 there was imminent risk of harm to the child involved.

1 B. The Department shall document:

2 1. The age of the child involved;

3 2. The facility's efforts to mitigate the risk before, during,
4 and after the noncompliance;

5 3. The length of time the facility was out of compliance; and

6 4. The facility's record of compliance during the previous
7 twelve-month period.

8 C. If Child Welfare Services conducts an investigation and
9 finds that the complaint was unsubstantiated, Child Care Services
10 shall not investigate further.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
