11	An Act relating to wildlife; authorizing the
12	Department of Wildlife Conservation to establish the Deer Management Assistance Program Plus (DMAP+); allowing for voluntary participation in DMAP+ by
13	certain individuals; requiring the Department to prepare certain forms and application for
14	participation; establishing criteria for participation; prohibiting individuals from certain
15	provisions; establishing fees; requiring participants to submit certain report to the Department by certain
16	time; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.
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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
21	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-316 of Title 29, unless there
23	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
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- 1 The Department of Wildlife Conservation is hereby authorized 2 to establish the Deer Management Assistance Program Plus (DMAP+). DMAP+ shall be a voluntary wildlife management program administered 3 by the Department to provide private landowners, hunting clubs, or 4 5 lease operators with an extended deer gun season and a regulated harvest quota system aimed at improving deer herd structure, habitat 6 sustainability, and overall population management. Individuals 7 participating in this program shall be required to adhere to 9 property-specific harvest plans established by state biologists, comply with quota-based harvest limitations, and pay an enrollment 10 fee as provided for in this section. 11
- B. The Department shall provide all necessary forms and applications for individuals seeking to participate in DMAP+.

 Individuals participating in DMAP+ shall:
- 1. Own or manage no fewer than one thousand (1,000) contiguous acres;
 - 2. Submit a completed application to the Department for enrollment; and

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- 3. Comply with all management guidelines as determined by the Department.
- C. DMAP+ shall allow for an extended deer gun season for enrolled properties, as follows:
- 1. Antlered deer rifle season beginning November 1 and ending
 December 31 each year; and

2. Antlerless deer rifle season beginning October 1 and ending January 15 of the following year.

- D. Each DMAP+ property shall be subject to certain harvest requirements as established by the Department. Individuals who exceed the established harvest requirements shall be in violation of this subsection. Violations are subject to penalties as prescribed by the Department.
- 8 E. The annual fee for participation in DMAP+ shall be as 9 follows:
- 1. For properties between one thousand (1,000) acres and five thousand (5,000) acres One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars

 (\$1,500.00); and
 - 2. For properties exceeding five thousand (5,000) acres Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00).
 - F. Landowners participating in DMAP+ shall electronically submit an annual report to the Department detailing the number, age, and sex of deer harvested on the enrolled property. Failure to submit the report within thirty (30) days of the conclusion of each designated season may result in suspension or removal from DMAP+ participation.
 - G. The Department shall promulgate all rules necessary for the implementation of this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
