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10 POLICY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

11 An Act relating to retail electric suppliers;
12 prohibiting certain incentivization by suppliers to
13 customers; providing for codification; providing an
14 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 801.10 of Title 17, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 No rate-regulated retail electric supplier, as defined in
20 Section 158.22 of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall offer
21 ratepayer-funded incentives, rebates, or inducements to its
22 customers to promote the switching of fuel sources from natural gas
23 to electricity.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
