11	An Act relating to discrimination; adopting certain definition of anti-Semitism; stating purposes for use
12	of certain definition; construing provisions; providing for codification; providing an effective
13	date; and declaring an emergency.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1911 of Title 25, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. The State of Oklahoma hereby adopts the non-legally binding
21	Working Definition of Anti-Semitism adopted by the International
22	Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) on May 26, 2016, including the
23	contemporary examples of anti-Semitism set forth therein,
24	exclusively as a tool and guide for training, education, and

1	recognizing and combating anti-Semitic hate crimes or discrimination
2	and for tracking and reporting anti-Semitic incidents in this state.
3	B. The provisions of this act shall not be construed to
4	diminish or infringe upon any right protected under the First
5	Amendment to the United States Constitution or the Oklahoma
6	Constitution.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
8	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
