

1 B. Exceptions to paragraph 1 of subsection A of this section
2 are:

3 1. Dead fish or wildlife legally taken by licensed hunters or
4 fishermen for noncommercial purposes may be possessed, shipped, or
5 transported into or within the borders of this state if it is
6 accompanied by or has attached the appropriate certificate, license,
7 or tag as may be required by the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation
8 Code, rules, or the laws of another state;

9 2. Rough fish products that have been completely processed into
10 food or other products that legally taken fish may yield may be
11 exported from the state;

12 3. Any rough fish taken by licensed commercial fishermen who
13 have been issued a special permit as required by Section 4-105 of
14 this title by the Director of Wildlife Conservation may be shipped,
15 transported, or exported pursuant to the permit;

16 4. Any fish or wildlife lawfully bred or propagated may be
17 shipped or transported within the confines of this state or exported
18 out of this state;

19 5. Any wildlife for which the Director has given an individual
20 specific written authority for its transportation into or out of the
21 state; ~~or~~

22 6. Any farmed cervidae licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Farmed
23 Cervidae Act; or

1 7. Any deceased, intact cervidae in transit into this state to
2 a taxidermist who is in good standing with the Secretary of State.

3 C. An owner or operator of a commercially licensed hunting
4 facility shall be permitted to transport cervidae from one in-state
5 hunt facility to another in-state hunt facility without a permit
6 issued by the Department of Wildlife Conservation.

7 D. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
8 section shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars
9 (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), or by
10 imprisonment in the county jail for a period not less than ten (10)
11 days nor more than sixty (60) days, or by both.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
