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10                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11                   An Act relating to groundwater permits; amending 82  
12                   O.S. 2021, Section 1020.7, which relates to  
13                   groundwater permit applications; requiring certain  
14                   license be presented for persons intending to use  
15                   groundwater for medical marijuana grow facilities;  
16                   providing an effective date; and declaring an  
17                   emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19                   SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           82 O.S. 2021, Section 1020.7, is  
20                   amended to read as follows:

21                   Section 1020.7. Any person intending to use groundwater shall  
22                   ~~make application~~ apply to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board for an  
23                   appropriate permit as provided in Section 1020.11 of this title  
24                   before commencing any drilling for such purposes and before taking  
                  water from any completed well heretofore drilled. Such application

1 to take and use groundwater shall be on a form provided by the Board  
2 and pursuant to the rules and regulations established by the Board.  
3 Any person intending to use groundwater for a medical marijuana grow  
4 facility shall present to the Board a valid medical marijuana  
5 commercial grower license issued by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana  
6 Authority pursuant to Section 427.14 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma  
7 Statutes.

8 The application heretofore filed with the Board shall be used in  
9 granting permits for existing wells and the Board shall publish the  
10 notice of the hearing thereon.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
