It is required that the The board of education shall 6 provide notice to the student, his or her parent, attorney, or legal 7 guardian that said the student is entitled to an executive session 8 9 regarding the discussion of his or her expulsion or suspension $\frac{\partial f}{\partial t}$ said student. 10

Any action taken in violation of the provisions of this act
Section 5-101 et seq. of this title shall be invalid.

Each member of the board of education of a school district with 13 an average daily attendance exceeding fifteen thousand (15,000) or a 14 school district where boundaries encompass a total population 15 exceeding one hundred thousand (100,000) persons according to the 16 last preceding Federal Decennial Census may be paid from the 17 district's general fund a stipend of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) 18 One Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$190.00) for each regular, special, or 19 adjourned meeting of the board of education that he or she attends, 20 but not for more than four meetings in any calendar month. 21 SECTION 2.
