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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
15	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Food is
16	Medicine Act".
17	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4002.14a of Title 56, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	Subject to receipt of any necessary federal approval for the
21	Food is Medicine Initiative under Section 3 of this act, the
22	Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall implement a financial incentive
23	for contracted entities who improve health outcomes of covered
24	members through nutrition services provided under the initiative.

- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5009.7 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
 - A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall seek any necessary federal approval to expand covered nutrition services under the state Medicaid program for the purpose of implementing a Food is Medicine Initiative.
 - B. The Food is Medicine Initiative shall be designed to improve health outcomes for Medicaid members through nutrition services and reduce the need for medical care.
 - C. Nutrition services covered under the Food is Medicine
 Initiative may include, but are not limited to:
 - 1. Case management;

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- 2. Nutrition counseling;
- 3. Meals or pantry stocking;
- 16 4. Nutrition prescriptions; and
- 17 5. Grocery provisions.
- SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-147.2 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- 21 The State Department of Education shall provide, to schools who 22 apply for grants under the Oklahoma Farm to School Program Act 23 codified at Section 5-60.1 et seq. of Title 2 of the Oklahoma 24 Statutes, technical assistance with applying for grants and

administering programs that expand student access to fresh, healthy food. SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
