A public construction contract shall provide 18 for partial payment based upon work completed. The contract shall 19 provide that up to five percent (5%) of all partial payments made 20 shall be withheld as retainage until the project is fifty percent 21 (50%) complete as determined by the awarding agency. When the 22 awarding public agency determines that the project is at least fifty 23 percent (50%) complete, the retainage amount shall be two and one-

half percent (2.5%) with respect to the balance of the work.

1	B. The Department of Transportation or the Oklahoma Turnpike
2	Authority shall not withhold retainage on public construction
3	contracts awarded by the Department or the Authority.
4	C. The Department of Transportation shall not withhold
5	retainage or require any bond on projects awarded to railroads on
6	the railroad's privately owned or operated rail property.
7	D. Construction contracts or subcontracts subject to a bond
8	shall not withhold retainage.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
