Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 1122 makes multiple changes to statute regarding the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission. The measure:

- Separates the Commission from the State Department of Health, deeming it a separate and distinct agency;
- Authorizes the Athletic Commission to have jurisdiction over professional boxing and kickboxing;
- Allows the Commission to halt the unlicensed promotion of professional combative sports and seek penalties against those who coordinate such unsanctioned events;
- Clarifies when and how testing for HIV, hepatitis B and hepatitis C must be conducted;
- Removes the ability to waive the requirement for such certified test results.
