Research Analysis

The subcommittee recommendation to HB 1125 requires the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) to pay for the installation, repair, and maintenance costs for any curbs, inlets, inlet grates, inlet hoods, and inlet structures on municipal streets that are a continuation of the state or federal highway system except when performing mill and inlay projects. ODOT is only required to cover such costs in municipalities with a population of 100,000 or less.

Fiscal Analysis

According to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), this measure will increase agency cost on projects by about \$4,200,000.00, per year based on 1% of the qualifying areas in the state being addressed per year. As ODOT is an appropriated agency, there is a potential fiscal impact to the state budget of \$4,200,000.00 per year.
