HB 1155 requires the Department of Public Safety to develop a pursuit alert system to alert drivers of active police pursuits occurring in their immediate area.

Fiscal Analysis

HB1155 sets forth that the Department of Public Safety (DPS) shall establish and maintain a pursuit alert system. Officials with DPS have provided the following information:

Establishing and maintaining a pursuit alert system that is compliant with the provisions of the measure would require implementing modifications to the Integrated Public Alert and Warning System (IPAWS) and Everbridge system. The cost would be roughly \$1,000,000 for each system.

Therefore, DPS would seek additional funding to defray the total \$2,000,000 cost to upgrades IPAWS and Everbridge in an effort to maintain compliance with the provisions of HB1155.
