Research Analysis

HB 1162, as introduced, creates the Real Access to Whole Milk Act of 2025 which makes it unlawful for somebody to sell but not distribute milk or milk products without an appropriate and valid permit. The provisions of the act do not include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers at the farm where it is produced where the average number of gallons sold does not exceed 500 or 300 hundred for goat milk.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1162 statutorily changes "distribute" to "sell" in regards to permitting of milk or milk products as well as establishes thresholds of incidental raw milk and goat milk sales. Upon review, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
