Fiscal Analysis

HB 1167 permits certain persons to serve as precinct officials in any county of the state regardless of their home of record. The measure uses permissive language and does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
