**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1374 allows certain companies and individuals that produce power on their premises avoid being regulated as a public utility if they use the power directly for themselves, or indirectly to serve a specific customer, or they are an exempt wholesale generator. The measure clarifies that a public utility is not required to serve a customer receiving electric service from an entity described above.
