Research Analysis

HB 1393, as introduced, requires the State Board of Education to create separate forms that school districts must use to obtain parental consent for the following IEP-related actions:

- placing a student in the general education environment for less than 80% of the day, or
- determining that a student will participate in the Oklahoma Alternative Assessment Program.

The measure requires schools to hold an IEP team meeting with the parent if they determine the above actions are necessary. The measure outlines the procedure for schools and parents to follow when considering such changes to a student's IEP.
