Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 1469 requires the Tax Commission to report the following for the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax Credit:

- the total dollar amount of tax credits claimed each year broken down by individual private schools;
- statewide aggregate dollar amount awarded to homeschool students;
- the number of tax credits awarded and the number of students awarded broken down by individual private school;
- the dollar amount of tax credits awarded and the number of students awarded broken down by income categories;
- the number of applicants denied and the total dollar amount of credits the denied applications represent broken down by individual private school and/or homeschool;
- the total cost for tuition disaggregated by individual private school for each school year;
- the dollar amount for each of the following categories:
 - o tuition and fees for nonpublic learning programs, online or in person,
 - o academic tutoring services provided by an individual or a private academic tutoring facility,
 - o textbooks, curriculum, or other instructional materials, o fees for nationally standardized assessments
