**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB1621 requires the State Treasurer to create a publicly available Internet-based portal for the State Department of Education (OSDE) to submit and report all of its expenditure for each fiscal year. The data submitted will be displayed in database form and must be prominently featured on both the State Treasurer's and OSDE's website.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 1621 does not materially alter the fiscal impact statement for the original measure. Implementation of the measure would likely require a one-time cost of \$280,000 and a recurring maintenance cost of \$185,000. Additionally, one FTE would be necessary for implementation of the measure, which would cost approximately \$75,000 recurring.
