### **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2109 brings political subdivision campaign finance enforcement within the purview of the Oklahoma Ethics Commission (Commission). The measure makes the Commission the repository of certain related information so that the agency may better review it. The Commission expects to absorb any associated administrative costs within existing budgetary resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
