HB 2294, as introduced, requires the Commission for Human Services to promulgate rules which may encompass limitations on where new group homes are permitted but are not required to do so. The measure requires the Commission for Human Services to promulgate rules that address the group home and resident matters listed in statute within 180 days of the effective date of the Community Residential Living for Persons with Developmental or Physical Disabilities Act.
