**Research Analysis**

SB 1024 requires an agency promulgating or amending any emergency or permanent rule or rules to prepare a statement of scope of the rule or rules that it plans to promulgate. The statement must include a description of the objective of the rule; a description of any existing policies, newly proposed policies and an analysis of alternatives to adopting the rule; the statutory authority for promulgating the rule; estimates of the amount of time that would be spent by state employees to develop the rule and other resources that would be utilized to develop the rule; a description of all the entities that may be affected by the rule; and a summary and comparison of any existing or proposed federal regulation that is intended to address the activities to be regulated by the rule. The statement is to be submitted to the Secretary of State who will make a determination as to the authority of the agency to promulgate the rule by reporting to the Governor who may approve or reject the statement of scope. The agency may proceed with promulgation after receiving written notice of approval from the Governor. Statements of scope expire 30 months after the date of publication in the Oklahoma Register.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1024 prescribes requirements towards state agencies seeking to promulgate or amend emergency or permanent rules. The measure does not carry any fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
