Research Analysis

SB363 provides institutions that grant degrees used for religious purposes within a religious organization an exemption from accreditation by the State Regents. The measure requires all private and out-of-state public degree-granting institutions to be domiciled within the United States. And lastly, it directs the State Regents' policies and procedures regarding private and out-of-state institutions to include outcomes and student consumer protection.
