Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for SB382 requires children to be potty trained before enrolling in pre-k. Parents are required to complete a form assuring the school district that their child is potty trained. Children with disabilities would be exempt.

The measure requires the State Department of Education to create a process for schools to follow when a child is enrolled, but is not potty trained. *Not potty trained* is defined as three or more incidents of the child soiling or wetting themselves over a four week period.

Such a child may be temporarily withdrawn until they are fully trained. A school could also refer the parents to potty training resources or allow the parent to aid in the training as needed.
