**Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation to SB 527 extends the time at which a secured party must deliver a lien entry form and the required lien filing fee from 25 days to 45 days to Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator when creating a security interest in a vehicle. The measure clarifies when a secured party is to mail an additional copy of a release to a dealer to be after the receipt of a written request from a licensed used motor vehicle dealer.
