**Research Analysis**

SB 544 renames the Fraudulent Documents Identification (FDI) Unit within the Department of Public Safety as the Identity Verification Unit (IVU). The measure clarifies that the Department of Public Safety is the only law enforcement agency to have access to any information collected through the use of computerized finger imaging without obtaining a court order. The recipient and chief administrator of the law enforcement agency that requests the issuance of a fictitious driver license for criminal investigation purposes shall be jointly responsible to ensure the license is promptly returned to the Department of Public Safety.
