**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to SB 599 removes the requirement that a previous offense of forcible anal or oral sodomy, rape, or rape by instrumentation of a child under 14 be in place in order for a person convicted of such crime to be eligible for the death penalty. The measure provides that a person convicted of lewd molestation of a child under 12 years of age is to be punished by death, for a term of imprisonment of not less than 10 years, life, or life without parole.
