**Research Analysis**

SB 607 provides that a statement describing or reporting a domestic abuse incident made by the victim to a law enforcement officer within 1 week of the incident, a protective order filed within 1 week of the incident, or given testimony at a hearing on application for a protective order is to be admissible in pre-trial or post-trial criminal and juvenile delinquent domestic abuse prosecutions.
