**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 880 makes changes to the membership requirements for the Oklahoma Board of Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors, requiring that each of the six licensed or certified alcohol and drug counselors must be in good standing and have at least three years of experience in the state. The measure strikes language that requires at least five members of the Board to have at least a Master's degree.
