**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 96 provides definitions for *cell-cultured meat* and *insect-protein food product*. The measure outlines that no person advertising, offering for sale, or selling meat can engage in any misleading or deceptive practices including failing to fully disclose that a product is a cell-cultured meat or is an insect-protein product. The State Board of Agriculture must promulgate rules needed to enforce compliance with the Oklahoma Meat Consumer Protection Act.
