**Bill Analysis**

HB 1075 modifies language regarding a recommendation to dismiss or not reemploy a teacher. It makes such provisions applicable to administrators. The measure states that if the recommendation includes grounds that could form the basis of criminal charges for which an individual's license or certificate could be suspended or revoked, a copy of the recommendation is to be forwarded to the State Board of Education when it is made pursuant to due process procedures, regardless of whether the teacher or administrator resigns before or after a termination recommendation is made. It directs a report of any such resignation including any investigatory findings to be forwarded to the Board. It states that if the investigation concludes without findings to support criminal charges, certificate revocation, or termination, the report is to be expunged from Board records and a written notification is to be sent to all affected parties.

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
