**Bill Analysis**

SB 1028 requires applicants for the office of notary public to submit to a national criminal history record check. The check shall also be conducted for renewal applications. The measure authorizes the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to levy a maximum fee of \$50.00 to conduct the search. The measure also increases the bond from \$1,000.00 to \$10,000.00.
