**Bill Analysis**

SB 1096 authorizes the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House to submit select 3 bills each to be submitted to the Insurance Department for the purpose of conducting an impact analysis. The Department shall conduct an analysis of at least 6 bills and any subsequent amendments to the selected bills that may affect the analysis. Any analysis beyond the 6 submitted by the Pro Tempore and Speaker shall be subject to the availability of funds for the Department. The Department shall use third-party vendors to conduct the analysis. The Department may seek input from other agencies in the analysis. The Department shall provide an electronic copy to the Senate and the House and make the report available on the publicly available legislative website. The measure prohibits the consideration of any bill providing for a mandate impacting health plans unless an impact analysis is conducted.
