**Bill Analysis**

SB 280 creates the Feral Swine Eradication and Control Grant Program. The Program shall provide Oklahomans with education, equipment, and services associated with the eradication and control of feral swine. The measure directs the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to coordinate with the Department of Wildlife Conservation and the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to distribute resources for the capture or eradication of feral swine. The total maximum grant fund shall be no more than \$500,000.00 and shall be derived from legislative appropriations and other public and private sources.
