Bill Analysis

SB 363 modifies language regarding accreditation of private and out-of-state institutions of higher education. The measure requires private and out-of-state public degree-granting institutions to be domiciled within the United States or a United States district or territory. It directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's policies and procedures regarding private and out-of-state institutions to include outcomes and student consumer protection. The bill also exempts from the State Regents' accreditation religious degree-granting institutions and degree-granting institutions in this state that offer religious degrees used solely for religious purposes.
