**Bill Analysis**

SB 743 provides that any person convicted of paying for sexual conduct shall be subject to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 3 years and up \$1,000.00 in fines for the first conviction, \$2,500.00 in fines for the second conviction, and \$5,000.00 in fines for third and subsequent convictions. The measure authorizes first time offenders to enter into a plea agreement that includes commercial sex buyer diversion programming or a combination of diversion programming and imprisonment. Subsequent offenders shall be subject to jail time, regardless of the plea agreement.
