**Bill Analysis**

SB 94 creates the Oklahoma Commission on Race and Equality. The Commission shall be comprised of 13 members. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor shall each appoint 3 members respectively. The Oklahoma Legislative Black Caucus shall appoint 4 members. Each member shall be appointed for 3-year terms. Each member may be removed by the appointing authority for cause. Members shall receive no salary but shall be entitled to travel reimbursements. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide staff. The Commission shall advise on matters of equality relating to racial discrimination, monitor legislation, act as a clearinghouse for research, conduct meetings and seminars, and submit an annual report to the President Pro Tempore, Speaker, and Governor. The measure also establishes the Oklahoma Commission on Race and Equality Revolving Fund.
