**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

This bill modifies language related to school accreditation. It requires a school district prior to its accreditation status being changed from warning to probation or from probation to non-accredited to be given an opportunity to request a hearing before the State Board of Education. It requires the Board to provide the district with a notice of a right to a hearing withing the State Department of Education. If the district fails to request a hearing within 10 working days of receipt of the notice, the right to a hearing is waived. The bill directs the Board to promulgate rules regarding notice and hearing of accreditation status.

This bill has no fiscal impact.
