**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB1588 directs the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to complete a comprehensive watershed-based water quality plan designed to improve and protect the water quality and aquatic habitat in the Spring Creek watershed through voluntary, incentive-based programs, and publish an electronic report by June 1, 2026. The proposal creates the Spring Creek Watershed Study Cash Fund Revolving Fund.

The Conservation Commission states that there is \$50,000 in federal funds from the Environmental Protection Agency that would cover the cost of the study. There is no fiscal impact to the state.
