**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB2756 creates the High Voltage Electric Transmission Facility Act, requiring transmission developers to apply for a certificate of authority from the Corporation Commission for each electric transmission facility, and prohibits the commencement of a facility without obtaining a certificate authority. The proposal lists notification requirements for the developer, clarifies that developers cannot exercise eminent domain that is not already provided by statute, and directs the Commission to promulgate rules.

The Corporation Commission estimates a fiscal impact of \$15,000 annually, and a one-time cost of \$8,000 to promulgate rules.
