## **Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 194 has the Department of Human Services opt into and administer the Summer Electronic Benefits Transfer program starting the 2026 program year.

DHS has an estimated cost of approximately \$7,000,000, of which the state share would be \$3,500,000. DHS estimates that there are between 403,000 and 640,000 children that would qualify for this program.
