**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 478 removes all permitting and licensing to hunt feral swine regardless of the time of day and requires any person intending to kill or hunt feral swine at night obtain written permission from the landowner or agricultural lessee. The proposal allows the Department of Wildlife Conservation to automatically revoke the hunting or fishing license for no less than one year of a person found in violation of subsection C of Section 4 of the proposal.

The committee substitute creates no fiscal impact on the state.
