12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.12 of Title 21, unless there			
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
15	A. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause and			
16	with intent to do bodily harm, commits any assault upon the person			
17	of a municipal, county, or state official who is in the lawful			
18	performance of his or her duties of employment, upon conviction, is			
19	guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the			
20	county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, or by a fine not			
21	to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and			
22	imprisonment.			
23	B. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause and			
24	with intent to do bodily harm, commits any battery or assault and

battery upon the person of a municipal, county, or state official who is in the lawful performance of his or her duties of employment, upon conviction, is guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed five (5) years, or by a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

C. As used in this section, "official" means any code 7 enforcement official, zoning official, fire official, police 8 9 official, health official, safety official, building official, or deputies thereof, or any other person designated by county 10 legislation, municipal ordinance, or state statutes to lawfully 11 investigate, enforce, or perform duties set within such legislation, 12 13 ordinance, or statutes, as adopted by the governing body thereof. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025. 14
