8 An Act relating to civil procedure; providing for
9 records of certain forcible entry and detainer
10 actions from being public records; exempting records
11 of certain forcible entry and detainer actions from
the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1148.17 of Title 12, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 All court records relating to a forcible entry and detainer
20 action in which the court dismisses the action, the plaintiff drops
21 the action, or when the court rules in favor of the defendant the
22 records of that action shall not be considered public records and
23 shall not be subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records
24 Act.
