L7	A. The Oklahoma Legislature hereby establishes a moratorium on

21	Oklahoma Legislature, the moratorium shall be in effect indefinitely

23	B. Subject to the moratorium set by subsection A of this

section, no state agency, authority, board, commission, committee,

department, trust or other instrumentality of this state or

political subdivision thereof, nor elected or appointed officer,

member of any governing body or other person designated to act for

an agency or on behalf of the state, or a political subdivision

thereof, shall permit the construction or expansion of wind or

utility-scale solar energy facilities in this state.

- C. Nothing in this section shall be construed as affecting or intending to affect:
- 1. Any construction or expansion of wind or utility-scale solar energy facilities in this state that were properly permitted for construction or expansion and that have obtained official approval from the Regional Transmission Organization and are commercially operable prior to the passage and approval of this act; or
- 2. The operation of wind or utility-scale solar energy facilities in operation prior to the passage and approval of this act.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
