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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2301 of Title 6, unless there is
16	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A banking institution, at its discretion, may allow a surviving
18	spouse to take control of any bank account of the deceased, which
19	shall include but is not limited to checking and savings accounts.
20	Before allowing the surviving spouse to take control of any account
21	owned by the deceased, the banking institution shall require a death
22	certificate for the deceased which lists the name of the surviving
23	spouses along with two forms of government issued identification
24	with one being a photo identification which shall include but is not

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1	limited to a driver license and passport. The name of the spouse
2	listed on the death certificate must match the name on the
3	government issued identification. The banking institution shall
4	make photo or digital copies of the death certificate and the two
5	forms of identification and maintain such copies for their records
6	and shall maintain such records for ten (10) years.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
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
