- A. As used in this section, "law enforcement agency" shall mean the police department of any county sheriff's department.
- B. 1. A law enforcement agency shall equip each vehicle used in a canine law enforcement program with a heat alarm system that is activated when the vehicle stops running or the temperature in the vehicle's interior exceeds eighty-five degrees (85) Fahrenheit.
  - 2. The system, when activated, must:

- a. activate an audible alarm;
- b. automatically lower the vehicle's rear windows; and
- c. notify the canine law enforcement officer of the dangerous situation.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9301 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. As used in this section, "law enforcement agency" shall mean any police department with statewide jurisdiction as well as any university or college campus police.
