10	WHEREAS, National Crime Victims' Rights Week is April 6-12,
11	2025; and
12	WHEREAS, the theme this year for National Crime Victims' Rights
13	Week is "Kinship, Connecting, and Healing"; and
14	WHEREAS, advocates believe all victims deserve equal rights
15	throughout the judicial system; and
16	WHEREAS, the rights of victims being pursued aim to provide
17	coequal protections that are no more and no less than the rights
18	afforded to those accused and convicted of crimes; and
19	WHEREAS, consideration, awareness, and a voice for victims are
20	central to the remembrance of victims during National Crime Victims'
21	Rights Week; and
22	WHEREAS, Oklahoma agrees that victims should always be treated
23	with fairness and respect throughout the criminal justice process,
24	protected from the defendant, provided reasonable opportunities to

be heard at public proceedings regarding his or her case, and given
 a voice throughout each process of the case; and

3 WHEREAS, National Crime Victims' Rights Week serves to recognize 4 the needs of crime victims and statewide advocacy organizations that 5 are dedicated to guaranteeing victims' rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

8 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives hereby proclaims the 9 week of April 6, 2025 through April 12, 2025, as National Crime 10 Victims' Rights Week and proclaims Thursday, April 9, 2025, as 11 Victims' Rights Day.

12 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives will join efforts 13 with advocacy organizations throughout the State of Oklahoma to 14 continue recognizing and supporting victims' rights.

15 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives reaffirms its 16 commitment to help protect the rights of all Oklahoma crime victims, 17 year-round.
