7	An Act relating to the Conservation District Act;
8	amending 27A O.S. 2021, Section 3-1-103, which relates to definitions; modifying definitions;
9	updating statutory language; and providing an effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2021, Section 3-1-103, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 3-1-103. As used in the Conservation District Act:
16	1. "District" or "conservation district" means a governmental
17	subdivision of this state, and a public body corporate and politic,
18	organized in accordance with the provisions of the Conservation
19	District Act, for the purposes, with the powers, and subject to the
20	restrictions hereinafter set forth;
21	2. "Director" means a member of the governing body of a
22	conservation district, elected or appointed in accordance with the
23	provisions of the Conservation District Act;
24	3. "Commission" means the Oklahoma Conservation Commission;

4. "State" means the State of Oklahoma;

5. <u>"Agency of this state" includes</u> <u>"Agency" or "agency of this</u> <u>state" means</u> the government of this state and any subdivision, agency or instrumentality, <u>whether</u> corporate or otherwise, of the government of this state;

6 6. "United States" or "agencies of the United States" includes 7 the United States of America, and any department, agency or 8 instrumentality of the federal government;

9 7. "Government" or "governmental" includes the government of 10 this state, the government of the United States, and any 11 subdivision, agency or instrumentality, corporate or otherwise, of 12 either of them;

13 "Due notice" which shall be in conformance with the 8. 14 Administrative Procedures Act means notice published at least twice, 15 with an interval of at least seven (7) days between the two 16 publication dates, in a newspaper or other publication of general 17 circulation within the district, or, if no such publication of 18 general circulation is available, by posting at five conspicuous 19 places within the district, such posting to include, where possible, 20 posting at public places where it may be customary to post notices 21 concerning county or municipal affairs generally. At any hearing 22 held pursuant to such notice, at the time and place designated in 23 such notice, adjournment may be made from time to time without the 24 necessity of renewing such notice for such adjourned dates; _ _

9. "District cooperator" means any person that has entered into a cooperative agreement with a conservation district for the purpose of protecting, conserving and practicing wise use of the renewable natural resources under his or her control;

⁵ 10. "Renewable natural resources", "natural resources" or ⁶ "resources" include land, soil, water, vegetation, trees, natural ⁷ beauty, scenery and open space;

8 11. "Conservation" includes conservation, development,
9 improvement, maintenance, <u>management</u>, preservation, <u>restoration</u>,
10 <u>rehabilitation</u>, protection and wise use of land, water and related
11 natural resources; the control and prevention of floodwater and
12 sediment damages; and the disposal of excess surface waters <u>for the</u>
13 <u>public benefit and sustainable social and economic utilization</u>;

14 12. <u>"Cost-Share</u> <u>"Cost-share</u> program" means the assumption by 15 the state of a proportional share of the cost of installing 16 conservation structures, conservation practices or best management 17 practices on lands for public and environmental benefits;

18 13. "Best management practices" means a control method or 19 combination of control methods that is determined to be the most 20 effective and practicable means of preventing soil loss from erosion 21 or reducing the amount of nonpoint source pollution from a given 22 land use;

14. "Nonpoint source" shall have the same meaning as such word is defined by the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Act;

1 15. "Pollution" shall have the same meaning as such word is 2 defined by the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Act;

³ 16. "Nonpoint source working group" means an advisory group ⁴ established by the <u>Oklahoma</u> Conservation Commission to provide input ⁵ into the state's nonpoint source management and assessment program ⁶ and is open to federal, state and local environmental agencies and ⁷ natural resource agencies and other interested groups;

8 17. "Watershed" means an area of land that drains to a given 9 point;

10 18. "Blue Thumb Program" means a nonpoint source educational 11 program emphasizing water quality education, including volunteer 12 monitoring;

13 19. "Soil science" means the science which:

14a.is the study of physical, chemical, and biological15processes taking place in both naturally occurring and16reconstructed unconsolidated material formed by the17alteration of parent rock due to exposure at the18earth's surface, and

b. includes sampling, measuring, identification, characterization, classification, and mapping of soil materials and migration of water solute, air and other gaseous components in the unsaturated portion of the earth; and

24 20. "Soil scientist" means a person who:

1	a. has earned a baccalaureate or higher degree in a field
2	of soil science from an institution of higher
3	education which is accredited by a regional or
4	national accrediting agency, with a minimum of thirty
5	(30) semester hours or forty-five (45) quarter hours
6	of undergraduate work in a field of biological,
7	physical, or earth science with a minimum of fifteen
8	(15) semester hours of core soil science courses, and
9	b. has a specific and continuous record of related and
10	verifiable soil science work experience for two (2)
11	years. Publications in a soil science publication or
12	prior qualifications as an expert witness in
13	administrative or judicial proceeding, hearing or
14	trial shall be prima facie verification of experience
15	related to soil science.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
