## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring certain school district or technology center school to provide certain attestation to a school district or technology center school considering an individual for employment; providing for contents of attestation; requiring attestation to be provided on certain form; requiring certain actions for failure to request or provide certain attestation; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-101.25a of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A school district or technology center school that is considering an individual for employment shall request from the individual's current or former employing school district or districts or technology center school or schools an attestation to whether allegations of inappropriate behavior between the individual and a student or students were raised and whether there was a

pending or ongoing investigation of inappropriate behavior between the individual and a student or students. The attestation shall be provided on forms prescribed by the State Department of Education or the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education.

- B. If a school district or technology center school fails to request or fails to provide an attestation required by subsection A of this section:
- 1. The superintendent of the school district or technology center school shall be dismissed or not reemployed, subject to the provisions of the Teacher Due Process Act of 1990; and
- 2. The board positions of the school district board of education or technology center school district board of education shall be declared vacant, and individuals who held such positions shall be ineligible to serve on a school district board of education or technology center school district board of education for five (5) years. The Governor shall appoint board of education members necessary to constitute a quorum, as provided for in subsection F of Section 13A-110 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- C. If a school district or technology center school fails to provide an attestation required by subsection A of this section and a subsequent employing school district or technology center school is found liable in a civil action or agrees to a settlement of a civil action, the school district or technology center school that failed to provide the attestation shall be required to provide fifty

        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation

    of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
 7
    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and

    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
